



Paying for Home Care PLUS Services

- Often more affordable than an assisted living or nursing home facility.
- Services are covered by:
 - Private pay
Sliding fee scale available based on a financial assessment. You must show proof of financial need in order to qualify for the sliding fee scale reduced rate.
 - Elderbridge Area Agency on Aging and Iowa Department of Public Health Grants
Both are payers of last resort and you must meet financial guidelines in order to qualify.
 - Iowa Medicaid Waiver programs cover some services

What is Home Care PLUS?

Personalized Living Utilizing Services

- Services provided by nurses and home health aides that are designed to support independent living at home.
- These services not considered “skilled or medically necessary” but are designed to keep people as healthy and independent as possible in the comfort of their own home.
- Our services are beneficial for older individuals or those with a chronic disabling disease.
- The goal of care is often maintenance of health conditions and to prevent or prolong nursing home placement.
- Services will be tailored for individual needs and can be altered at any time should those needs change.



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Services offered

Health Maintenance Nursing

– provided by licensed nurses

- Health/Physical Assessment of a stable condition
- Medication Review & Management
- Foot/Toe/Nail care
- Health Teaching
- Lab Draws
- Chronic Illness Management
- Coordination of Care
- “On-call” 24 hours/day
- Supervision of Home Health Aides

Homemaker Services

– provided by certified home health aides

- Bathing
- Dressing
- Laundry and Linen washing
- Meal Preparation
- Toileting & Incontinence Care
- Exercises/Mobility Assistance
- Light Housekeeping
- Errands
- Companionship
- Medication reminders

Respite Care

– provided by certified home health aides

- Caregiver relief in the home setting
- Allows the caregiver to rest, run errands, etc.
